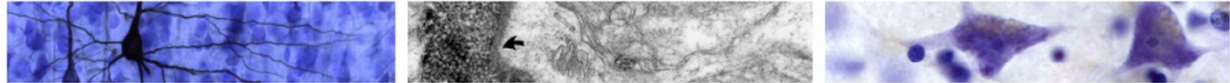

For freshman applicants only, one of the two letters of recommendation may be submitted by a teacher from your high school institution.
